When I was in seventh grade, my dad spent many nights studying with me for an important math test; in fact, I think it may have even been a final exam. We went over questions, and he gave me example after example until he felt that I was well-prepared for the test.

Here's where the confession comes...I didn't do well on the test. When my dad asked me, "Did you get your test back yet?" I didn't tell the truth, and I told him no. The teacher was taking a long time grading them, I said, so it would be a while before we would find out how we did.

It's been 25 years, and my dad still doesn't know I didn't do well on that math test. (Well, I guess he does now!) I never had the heart to tell him. I felt like I had let him down. We worked so hard, and I didn't produce the desired result.

As you can see, this has stuck with me over the years. I'm reminded of that story because today our students received their progress reports. After looking them over, I can tell you that a vast majority of our students are doing just fine. They just need to "stay on track" until the final report card. There are others, however, who have a few things to work on. That's what today is about.

Progress reports are not official documents. They're a "snapshot" of how a student is doing at this moment in time. The trimester is twelve weeks long, and this is only week six. There is plenty of time for students, families, and teachers to collaborate and work toward continued improvement and eventual success.

Thanks to modern technology, if I took that test today, the grade would've been posted on FACTS, and I wouldn't have been able to hide it. (Yikes!) More importantly, though, I shouldn't have kept my grade a secret. Students...Talk to your parents. Talk to your teachers. Don't wait until report card time. Take action now. We're here to help! Don't wait 25 years.
