Faux stained Glass with Foil paper and Sharpie Markers

Hello again my budding artists! Today we learn how to make faux stained-glass with foil paper and sharpie markers. Remember what the word "faux" means? I've attached the link to the video we looked at.

As requested in class, you need only do as far as making your foil canvas with your cardboard, and having your design etched out in glue. We should color and finish in the art room. However, if you'd like to complete it at home please feel free to do so!

Remember, if you do it at home you must use sharpie markers. Regular markers will not stain the foil paper. If you do not have a glue gun, you may use your black sharpie marker and do think lines to highlight your design lines. (Or, try Elmer's Clear glue with pointed tip and **do not use non-stick foil paper** - use the regular one instead and hopefully it works). Follow the instructions carefully. Remember you can do any design your hearts desire. Get the family involved or do it as a surprise for mum and dad.
