Last week, there was information in the Wednesday Folder regarding coronavirus preparedness. Please know that the custodial staff has been cleaning the building regularly both during school hours and after the children are dismissed. Please assist us by keeping home any child who exhibits signs of illness, especially a fever. In addition, **I ask that when you drop your child off in the morning, please do not walk him or her to class. School staff will walk our early childhood students to their respective classrooms, and all other students should head to wherever early morning drop-off students are being supervised.**

Usually, in this week’s folder we would be sending home report card conference notices. However, for **precautionary reasons, the Office of the Superintendent is cancelling all face-to-face report card conferences for the second trimester for all schools and academies in the Diocese of Brooklyn.** In place of the usual report card conferences, the following procedures will be in place:

- On Wednesday, March 18th two copies of the report card will be sent home in an envelope with a request that a parent sign one copy and return the signed parent copy back to the school on Thursday, March 19th. (Report cards will only be sent home if accounts are up-to-date.)
- If you feel it is necessary to make any appointment with you child’s teacher, please send in a note with the report card and/or email the teacher.
- **Friday, March 20th will still be a 12:30pm dismissal for all students.** Teachers will use this time to make phone calls and reply to emails.
- If a student is in danger of retention by the end of this Second Trimester, written notification will be sent home, signed by the principal, with a request for the parent to sign and return the notification letter to school.

As both a school administrator and parent, I understand what a trying and uncertain time this is. Thank you again for your cooperation and assistance. Should I receive any other notifications or updates from the Diocese, I will be sure to keep everyone informed.
